

Texas Hold'em Tournament

Friday, September 2, 2011 – 6:45pm.....Picnic Grounds

Entry Fee - \$40.00

Total Payout - 65 - 70% of gross entry fees

Top 10 - 12% will finish in the money

No Re-buys

Tournament will consist of a maximum of 64 players. We will start with eight tables of eight players. Players will be randomly placed at each table. Each player will start with \$1000 worth of chips.....(8) \$25 chips and (8) \$100 chips. This is a no limit tournament.

Late shows: Players arriving late will have their blinds forfeited when it comes their turn.

The blinds will be as follows and increase every 15 minutes. The initial blind will stay for thirty minutes....

25-25	100-200	500-1000	3000-6000
25-50	150-300	1000-2000	5000-10000
50-100	200-400	1500-3000	
75-150	300-600	2000-4000	

Players at each numbered table will begin play by dealing one card to each player in a showdown fashion to determine first dealer. High card deals first with ace being high and two being low. We will combine tables when the number of open chairs equals the number of players remaining at the smallest table. Cease play if your table reaches four players. This will be explained in greater detail the night of.

As long as you have one chip remaining, you are still alive. You do not have to have the full amount of the big blind to stay in the game – a side pot will be started. However, if at any point you do not have enough to match the big blind, you must go all in. Minimum bet must always match or exceed the big blind.

Misdeals...

A card placed face up in the deck will be treated as a scrap of paper and replaced by the next card in the deck.

If a player's hole card is exposed due to a dealer error, he may not keep the exposed card. After completing the deal, the dealer will exchange the exposed card with the top card in the deck and place the exposed card face up on top of the deck. The exposed card will be used as the first burn card after all action before the flop. If a player is dealt more or less cards than the (2) required, and it is discovered before two players act on their hands, then it is a misdeal. If it is discovered after two players act on their hands, then all monies and blinds are forfeited by that player.

If the flop has too many cards, it will be taken back and reshuffled except the burn card. It will remain burned and no new burn card will be used.

If cards are flopped by the dealer before all betting is complete, the entire flop is taken back and reshuffled. The burn card will remain and no additional burn card will be used.

If the dealer turns up the fourth card on the board before the round of betting is complete, the card is not in play. After betting is complete, the next card is burned and the fifth card is put in the fourth card's place. After betting is complete, the dealer will reshuffle the deck, including the card that was taken out of play, but not the burn card or discards. The dealer will then deal the fifth card.

If the fifth card is turned up before betting is complete, it shall be reshuffled in the same manner as previously listed.

If the flop, fourth, or fifth street is turned up before a card is burned, that card is taken back and burned. The next card is then flipped up.

Hands call themselves.

This is not a 100% payout tournament. Proceeds benefit St Remy Parish Picnic. Payout is as follows (if the tourney is full).

1 st – 500	2 nd – 250	3 rd – 200	4 th – 150
5 th – 125	6 th – 100	7 th – 75	8 th – 50

***In addition, we will be paying out \$5 for each player you knock out of the tournament.

Smoking is not permitted under the tent during tournament play

Sandwiches and drinks will be available.
